**COLONIAL INTERMEDIATE UNIT 20 ANNOUNCES REGIONAL MIDDLE SCHOOL COMPUTER FAIR WINNERS**

*April 6, 2009, Colonial Intermediate Unit 20*—Individuals and teams of students from middle schools within the Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 area (Northampton, Monroe and Pike counties) participated in the Pennsylvania Middle School Computer Fair regional competition on Monday, April 6, 2009 at Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 in Easton, PA.

Students in grades 6 through 8 were eligible to submit projects in the following six categories:

- **Desktop Publishing** - any project such as a newsletter, magazine or brochure designed using desktop publishing software
- **Digital Movie** - any digital movies (such as a documentary, public service announcement or commercial) created in iMovie, Moviemaker, Final Cut Pro, Media 100, etc.
- **Graphic Design** - artwork used in advertisements, stationery or pictures
- **Logo Design** - any logo designed for use on marketing materials such as t-shirts, mugs, mouse pads, posters, business cards, and/or letterhead
- **Multimedia**- any projects that include animation or video as part of a presentation
- **Web Page Design** - projects using FrontPage or Dreamweaver to create a public Web Page

Schools from the CIU 20 region represented at the competition included: Broughal Middle School (Bethlehem Area School District), Dingman-Delaware Middle School (Delaware Valley School District), JT Lambert Intermediate School (East Stroudsburg Area School District), and Wind Gap Middle School (Pen Argyl Area School District). A total of 43 students submitted 34 projects in the six categories.

Winners of the regional competition will represent Northampton, Monroe, and Pike counties at the statewide competition, at Dickinson College in Carlisle, PA on Wednesday, May 20, 2009. First place winners (a list of regional winners is available on page 2 of this release) at the regional level will advance to the state competition.

The Pennsylvania Middle School Computer fair is an annual event which allows students the opportunity to create projects which showcase and apply their computer knowledge.
